Introduction

The Floppy Drive Installation kit, for use on PS Series workstations, includes an external floppy drive, a cable, and four screws.

Before You Start

To mount the Floppy Drive, you will need the following items:


- Floppy Drive Kit FLP-1000 or FLP-2000
- Instructions
- Phillips screwdriver

Mounting the Floppy Drive

Mount Drive on Rear of Workstation

To mount the floppy drive on the rear of the workstation, follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the workstation off.
- 2. Find the four predrilled holes at the back of the workstation.



- 3. Attach the floppy drive to the rear of the workstation using the predrilled holes in the workstation and the four screws provided. Test access with a floppy disk.
- 4. Plug the floppy drive cable into the workstation port marked **floppy**.

Mount Drive Remotely

To mount the drive remotely, follow these steps:

- 1. Select a mounting location within reach of the cable provided.
- 2. Drill and deburr 4 holes in the selected mounting surface.
- 3. Attach the floppy drive to the mounting surface using the four screws provided.
- 4. Turn the workstation off.
- 5. Plug the floppy drive cable into the workstation port marked **floppy**.
